STANDARD EXPECTATIONS:

1. In circumstances where it becomes clear to you that you are unlikely to be able to submit/complete an assessment by the due/scheduled date, you should immediately discuss the matter with your subject teacher. Where appropriate, this discussion should take place when at least 25% of the assessment working time remains.
2. It is your responsibility to seek extensions BEFORE the due date. Extensions will normally be given for sickness and other genuine reasons only. Without an approved extension, a penalty for late work will be applied.
3. PLAGIARISM: Assigned or other work that is not your own but is presented as such will not be accepted.
4. REFERENCING: All responses to assessment tasks that contain the work of others must be correctly referenced. Further, a Bibliography must be provided where a range of texts and resources have been used for information if this is a requirement of the assessment task.
5. All work in each individual assessment task must be your original work. You are not permitted to submit for marking, as original, any work which contains:
 - identical or similar material to the work of another person (e.g. another student, a parent, a tutor)
 - identical or similar material to a published work unless the source is acknowledged in referencing or footnotes.
 - The use of AI-generated responses/information unless otherwise negotiated with their teacher.

BREACHES OF ASSESSMENT RULES

- The submission of work which is not your own in a subject may result in no credit for that assessment being awarded or a request to re-submit the assessment, with parents being contacted
- Penalties will occur where marks will be deducted for late work (up to 3 days after the due date) or work that is not submitted, may be awarded a 0 mark.
- Failure to submit any assessment will impact significantly on your level of achievement awarded by the teacher.
- Failure to submit any assessment may also impact on your Good Standing or your eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.
